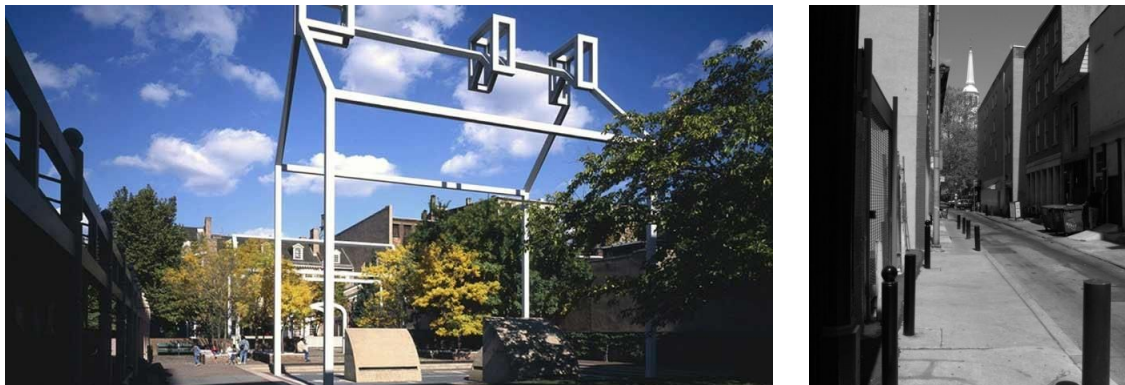

Following the Parry Family Footsteps in Philadelphia

Our tour begins with a visit to the new Museum of the American Revolution, See the greatest collection of Revolutionary War artifacts, including General George Washington's tent. Then, enjoy a delicious lunch at a classic Tuscan Grille in Old City.



Next, see the Philadelphia terminus of the Old York Road that the Parry family traveled regularly. Then, we are off to the Arch Street Friends Meetinghouse where the Parrys worshipped in Philadelphia, and visit the burial grounds, the final resting place of Jane Paxson Parry.



Stroll Arch Street, the most prominent Quaker street in Old City, pass by the Betsy Ross House and head over to Market Street to Benjamin Franklin's house. One block east, and we visit the site of Benjamin Parry's flour exporting warehouse.



Hop back on the bus and head over to the Spring Garden neighborhood where Benjamin's son, Oliver Parry, built more than 300 homes in the mid-19th century. See some of those gorgeous homes that still line Green Street and Mount Vernon Street.

Enjoy wine and snacks as we travel back to New Hope after a jam-packed day of fun and education in our nation's first capital.
